# Radiation Safety Reminder

## Emergency Response

- Good Intentions Can Harm
  - Protecting people, equipment and environment 😊
  - Sometimes our desire is to protect equipment in the path potential damage such as water without thinking of the problems it may cause
  - Out of concern for your health and safety, never enter an (lab) area that has warning signage without consulting lab staff (PI, lab manager) or the Radiation Safety Office
  - What is the exception?

# Judgement & Actions

- A situation may involve immediate action if life safety is a concern
- THERE IS NO NEED PANIC!
- ASAP after the event, call Radiation Safety
- Radiation Safety will evaluate you for potential contamination and recommendations

- If your building is interested in purchasing an AED, please let Fire & Life Safety know so we can add the unit(s) into our inspection cycle
- Maintenance costs are the responsibility of the department that owns the AED




# Building Evacuation Observations

- Building occupants need to be reminded to go to assembly points
- Assembly points are listed on building evacuation maps and in Occupant Emergency Plans
- Treat ALL fire alarm activations as a real fire
- Assist building occupants to use the nearest available exits




# Areas of Rescue Assistance

# Trust Me - "Winter is Coming"


- Keep exit areas clear of snow & ice
- Keep fire hydrants and standpipes clear of snow
- Call CARS for assistance

## When Seconds Count...

After a snowfall, remember to clear a three-foot radius around fire hydrants near your home.



# Building Occupant Emergency Plans

- OEPs should be submitted to UWPD
- Share your OEP with building occupants
- If you need an evacuation vest(s), let EH&S Fire & Life Safety know
- Update your OEP annually
