- ⌘ Currently working as a Family Medicine PA for the Monroe Clinic




Cardiac on Campus

Brittany Rose Derynda

- ⌘ Organization created in memory of my older brother Jon
- ⌘ Mission: To advocate for cardiovascular health and awareness in partnership with the American Heart Association, and to provide opportunities for students to explore health careers
 - ⌘ Spread awareness to an age group who doesn't normally see importance of heart health
- ⌘ Increasing awareness by:
 - ⌘ Cardiac courts
 - ⌘ Red Dress Dash
 - ⌘ CPR/AEDs on campus

PulsePoint

- & App for phone
- & Users who have indicated that they are trained in CPR and willing to assist will be notified if someone nearby is having cardiac emergency
- & Directs to exact location of cardiac emergency and nearest registered AED
- & Students constantly have phones accessible

CPR/AED Certification

- ⌘ According to American Heart Association: a victim's chance of surviving drops by 7-10% for every minute a normal heart beat isn't restored
- ⌘ CPR/AED certification opportunities:
 - ⌘ Cardiac on Campus- 2 times a year (fall and spring)
 - ⌘ Badger Watch- every January
 - ⌘ UWPD- once a month
 - ⌘ Red Cross- many times throughout the year
 - ⌘ Schedule class with your building/ department at a time of your convenience

Building Evacuation Routes



THIRD FLOOR PLAN








- AED Located:

AED Reminder

- ⌘ If your building is interested in purchasing an AED, please let Fire & Life Safety (Jeff Schiller) know so we can add the unit(s) into our inspection cycle
- ⌘ Maintenance costs are the responsibility of the department that owns the AED
- ⌘ Fire & Life Safety inspects AED twice a year:
 - ⌘ Pad & battery expiration dates
 - ⌘ Ready condition and self-test
 - ⌘ Provide CPR mask and other first aid items
